## PROCLAMATION

Whereas: Autism Spectrum Disorder or ASD is a term used to describe complex disorders of brain

development. These disorders are characterized, in varying degrees, by difficulties in social

interaction, verbal and nonverbal communication and repetitive behaviors.

Whereas: Autism is the fastest-growing serious developmental disability in the nation. ASD is now

estimated to effect 1 in every 42 boys and 1 in 189 girls. Recording over 3 million

individuals in the USA and tens of millions worldwide.

Whereas: More children will be diagnosed with autism this year than with AIDS, Diabetes, Obesity

and Breast Cancer combined. There is no known medical cause or cure for autism.

Whereas: The current cost of Autism to the society in the U.S. is a staggering \$137 Billion. This cost

is up from \$35 Billion in 2006 – just a seven years ago! The lifetime cost to an individual

living with ASD is estimated at \$2.3 Million!

Whereas: While there is currently no cure for Autism Spectrum Disorders – ASD, there is help for

families, friends, and patients in the form of education, support, and services available

statewide.

Whereas: The City of Bellevue recognizes the efforts of those organizations that raise funds and

promote awareness to Autism Spectrum Disorders (ASD), thereby improving the quality of human life for those that have or support those with ASD and to continue the research

to find the cause and the cure of ASD.

Now, therefore, I, Claudia Balducci, Mayor of the City of Bellevue, Washington and on behalf of

its City Council, do hereby proclaim April 2015 as:

and urge the citizens of Bellevue to show support by wearing Blue during the designated period.
