NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Bellevue City Council will hold a public hearing during its Regular Session on **Monday, May 18, 2015** in the City Council Chamber in Bellevue City Hall, 450 110th Avenue NE, to consider two proposed ordinances. The first ordinance is for a proposed Land Use Code Amendment that would allow additional multifamily units in the Crossroads Subarea/District E, through a Council-approved development agreement. The second ordinance for consideration of a proposed Development Agreement between Intracorp (developer) and the City to allow a mixed-use residential development on the former Top Foods grocery site in the Crossroads District E - referred to as the Crossroads Village proposal. This Development Agreement, in part, will outline the specific public benefits that must be provided with the proposed development. The purpose of the May 18, 2015 public hearing is to provide an opportunity to take written and oral comments regarding the proposed Land Use Code Amendment and the proposed Development Agreement.

All written comments received by the City Clerk or Director will be transmitted to the City Council no later than the date of the public hearing. 
