## **Land Use Code Process Options**

The Land Use Code is contained in Title 20 of the Bellevue City Code. For ease of use and administration the Land Use Code is published separately from the Bellevue City Code. Under state law, development regulations such as the Land Use Code must be processed in a certain way. As a result, the code amendment process for a Bellevue City Code amendment involving the Land Use Code differs from the process required for Bellevue City Code amendments that do not involve in the Land Use Code. For clarifications or ambiguous wording of the Land Use Code an Interpretation of the Land Use Code may be issued. The differences in these processes are illustrated below.
