The draft Land Use Element includes a set of housing and employment growth targets for the period 2006-31, with an extension of projected growth out to 2035 (Figure LU-2, p. 37 in the Commission-recommended draft plan). The Bellevue 2031 growth targets include 17,000 new housing units and 53,000 new jobs; these were adopted by the King County Council in January 2010, and later ratified by the Bellevue Council in April 2010 (Res. No. 8088). To meet the GMA requirement of planning for 20 years of growth, the target numbers provided in the draft plan were extended four years from 2031 to 2035. Attachment 6 provides an overview of growth targets and related information.
