SUBJECT

Resolution No. 8966 repealing Resolution No. 8953 and authorizing the submittal of a grant application requesting \$250,000 from the State of Washington's Recreation and Conservation Office (RCO) to assist with the cost of replacing the synthetic turf at Robinswood Park.

DESCRIPTION

On July 27, Council approved Resolution No. 8953 authorizing an application for up to \$250,000 from the State of Washington's Recreation and Conservation Office (RCO) to assist with funding the replacement of synthetic turf at Robinswood Park. RCO has specific requirements regarding an applicant's resolution that were described in the previous Agenda Memo but not included in the resolution. The attached resolution satisfies these requirements, thus making the City eligible to receive RCO funding.

If adopted by Council, this Resolution will become effective immediately.
