

CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON

ORDINANCE NO. 6269

AN ORDINANCE authorizing execution of an Interlocal Agreement (and any necessary supplements) with the Washington State Department of Ecology to accept reimbursement grant funds of up to \$102,455 from the Coordinated Prevention Grant (CPG) program to implement recycling and hazardous waste prevention and education programs; appropriating unanticipated and future revenues to the Solid Waste Fund; and authorizing expenditures of said grant funds.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON, DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The City Manager or his designee is authorized to execute an Interlocal Agreement (and any necessary supplements) with the Washington State Department of Ecology to accept reimbursement grant funds of up to \$102,455 from the Coordinated Prevention Grant (CPG) program to implement recycling and hazardous waste prevention and education programs, a copy of which Interlocal Agreement has been given Clerk's Receiving No. _____.

Section 2. The appropriate administrative officials of the City are hereby authorized to receive monies and to expend the same as authorized in said Interlocal Agreement.

Section 3. The City Manager or his designee shall have responsibility for the administration of said grant monies and shall have all authority necessary to enter into agreements regarding the use thereof including consultant agreements to expend funds as provided in said grant agreement.

Section 4. The approximate amount and anticipated source of revenue for the grant proposal and acceptance is:

Washington State Department of Ecology	\$102,455.00
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Section 5. Upon execution of said Interlocal Agreement, the budget for the Solid Waste Fund shall be amended by appropriating revenues in the amount of the grant and acceptance herein authorized.

Solid Waste Fund	\$102,455.00

Provided, however, if the actual revenue received from the anticipated source specified in said Interlocal Agreement should be more or less than the anticipated amount set forth herein, the appropriation shall be adjusted to be equal to the amount actually received.

Section 6. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force five (5) days after its passage and legal publication.
