

CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON

ORDINANCE NO. 6274

AN ORDINANCE amending the Parks 2015-2016 Capital Investment Program budget by (1) authorizing the execution of a project agreement with the State of Washington's Recreation Conservation Office to accept and expend \$1.75 million in increased grant funds; and (2) transfer \$221,000 in available Parks Levy Funds from the Bellevue Botanical Garden to the Bellevue Youth Theatre project.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON, DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The City Manager or his designee is hereby authorized to execute a project agreement with the State of Washington's Recreation Conservation Office to accept and expend \$1.75 million in increased grant funds, a copy of which agreement shall be substantially in the form given Clerk's Receiving No. _____.

Section 2. The Park's 2015-2016 Capital Investment Program (CIP) Fund appropriation adopted by Ordinance No. 6209 on December 1, 2014 as previously amended is hereby further amended to increase the appropriation to said CIP Fund by \$1,750,000 to recognize funding from the following:

Section 3. The City Manager or his designee is hereby further authorized to execute all documents necessary to fulfill the terms of the agreements authorized in Section 1.

Section 4. The appropriate administrative officials of the City are hereby authorized to receive monies and to expend the same as authorized in said grant agreements.

Section 5. If the actual revenue received from the anticipated sources specified in said grant agreements shall be more or less than the anticipated amount

set forth herein, the appropriations shall be adjusted to equal the amount actually received.

Section 6. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force five (5) days after its passage and legal publication.
