

CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON

ORDINANCE NO. 6310

AN ORDINANCE authorizing the execution of a cooperative agreement with the U.S. Department of Energy to accept funding for the project "Analyzing Drivers of Change in Greenhouse Gas Emissions Inventories"; authorizing acceptance of \$450,597 in funding from the U.S. Department of Energy; amending the 2015-2016 Operating Grants, Donations and Special Reserves Fund to increase appropriations by \$450,597; and authorizing expenditures of said grant funds.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON, DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The City Manager or his designee is authorized to execute a cooperative agreement with the U.S. Department of Energy to accept \$450,597 in funding for the project "Analyzing Drivers of Change in Greenhouse Gas Emissions Inventories," a copy of which agreement has been given Clerk's Receiving No. _____.

Section 2. The appropriate administrative officials of the City are hereby authorized to receive monies and to expend the same as authorized in said cooperative agreement.

Section 3. The City's 2015-2016 Operating Grants, Donations and Special Reserves Fund appropriation, adopted by Ordinance 6209 on December 1, 2014, as previously amended, is hereby further amended to increase the appropriation to said Fund by \$450,597 to recognize funding from the U.S. Department of Energy.

Section 4. If the actual revenue received from the anticipated source specified in the cooperative agreement should be more or less than the anticipated amount set forth herein, the appropriation shall be adjusted to be equal to the amount actually received.

Section 5. The City Manager or his designee shall have responsibility for the administration of said monies and shall have all authority necessary to enter into agreements regarding the use thereof.

Section 6. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force five (5) days after passage and legal publication.
