SUBJECT

Resolution authorizing the execution of an amendment to the contract between the City and Keating, Bucklin & McCormack, Inc., P.S., for legal services in the *Tateuchi v. City of Bellevue*, *et al.* lawsuit, to increase the total contract value to an amount not to exceed \$180,000.

FISCAL IMPACT

This action obligates the City to increase the total contract amount for legal services provided by Keating, Bucklin & McCormack, Inc., P.S., by \$98,000.

POLICY CONSIDERATION

Should the City continue to retain outside counsel to provide legal services for the City in this lawsuit?

BACKGROUND

On February 22, 2016, Ina Tateuchi applied to revoke the Conditional Use Permit issued to Kemper Development Company through Ordinance No. 6000. Tateuchi does not have standing to initiate revocation of another property owner's permit, and the City accepted this application in error. The City cancelled the application and refunded the application fees.

In response, Tateuchi filed an appeal with the Hearing Examiner and also filed suit in King County Superior Court. The City's outside counsel (the law firm of Keating, Bucklin & McCormack, Inc., P.S.) successfully moved to dismiss the Hearing Examiner proceeding on jurisdictional grounds, and Tateuchi has appealed that ruling. The initial superior court action also remains active.

EFFECTIVE DATE

If adopted, this Resolution will be effective immediately upon Council adoption.

OPTIONS

- 1. Adopt Resolution authorizing execution of the amendment to the Agreement with Keating, Bucklin & McCormack, Inc., P.S., increasing the total contract amount to an amount not to exceed \$180,000.
- 2. Do not adopt Resolution and provide alternative direction to staff.
