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# **EXECUTIVE SUMMARY**

As directed by Council at the September 17, 2018 Council meeting, staff have drafted a proposed Ordinance denying the appeal of the Hearing Examiner's April 5 Decision denying Ina Tateuchi's Application for Revocation of a Conditional Use Permit issued to Kemper Development Company for the development and use of a helistop on the Bellevue Place Building located at 10500 NE 8<sup>th</sup> Street, Bellevue, Washington.
