RESOLUTION NO. 9256

A RESOLUTION authorizing execution of amendments to all fixed price or not to exceed amount contracts, purchase orders and other written commitments (Agreements) meeting specified criteria to pay the applicable sales tax increase going into effect on April 1, 2017.

WHEREAS, on April 1, 2017, the Regional Transit Authority (RTA) tax will increase the sales tax from 9.5% to 10% in RTA taxing districts within Bellevue, Washington; and

WHEREAS, the City of Bellevue must pay applicable sales tax to vendors for certain contracts; and

WHEREAS, certain City fixed price contracts may require amendment to include the newly increased sales tax for billings after April 1, 2017; and

WHEREAS, this resolution is designed to globally authorize such amendments for contracts meeting the below criteria; now, therefore,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON, DOES
RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The City Manager or his designee is hereby authorized to execute amendments to all fixed price or not to exceed amount contracts, purchase orders and other written commitments (Agreements) meeting the following criteria: 1.) Agreements approved by Council prior to April 1, 2017 with fixed pricing that included the sales tax in effect prior to April 1, 2017; 2.) billing or other actions under the Agreement causing application of the increased sales tax effective on April 1, 2017; 3.) the amount of the tax is not within the 10% change order authorization for which Council approval is not needed; and 4) the additional tax amount can be paid from within the existing authorized budget or available funds for the Agreement.
