

Eastside Winter Shelter (EWS) CODE OF CONDUCT:

1. We need for all shelter residents to follow directions given to him by EWS staff.
2. We need for all shelter residents to be respectful and courteous of other guest, staff, and volunteers.
3. Physical violence of any kind will not be tolerated. Those involved in physical altercations will be banned indefinitely from the shelter.
4. Behaviors of verbal threats and bullying will not be tolerated. Depending on the level of threat or bullying, determined by staff, those involved may be asked to leave the shelter.
5. Drugs, alcohol, and weapons are not allowed at the shelter. Consequences will be given to anyone using drugs and/or alcohol at the shelter.
6. The selling of drugs, alcohol, or weapons will not be tolerated. Those involved will be reported to local law enforcement and banned indefinitely from the shelter.
7. Theft will not be tolerated. Those involved in theft will be reported to local law enforcement and banned indefinitely from the shelter.
8. EWS/CFH staff reserve the right to search personal belongings when investigating drug, alcohol, or theft incidents.
9. EWS staff reserves the right to contact emergency medical response for those significantly under the influence of drugs or alcohol.
10. We need for all shelter residents to be good neighbors. This includes:
 - a. Not loitering at the shelter site or the neighboring area, on 116th Ave NE between NE 4th and NE 8th, Street before 7:15pm and after 7:45am.
 - b. Cleaning up after yourself and not littering on the shelter property or in the neighboring area, on 116th Ave NE between NE 4th and NE 8th.
 - c. Not arguing loudly and disruptively in the shelter and in the neighboring area, on 116th Ave NE between NE 4th and NE 8th.
11. We need for all shelter residents to work together to keep the shelter space clean.
12. Smoking is only to occur in the designated smoking area(s).
13. Each shelter resident will be solely responsible for his own belongings. We advise that you keep a close eye on your belongings at all times.
14. Each shelter resident will be solely responsible for his personal medications.
15. Each shelter resident will need to arrive at the shelter by 10:30pm each night.
16. Once checked in, we cannot allow anyone to leave the shelter and return. Those who leave early cannot return to the shelter until the following evening.
