

CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON

ORDINANCE NO. 6354

AN ORDINANCE authorizing execution of a contract to accept reimbursement grant funds from King County to assist with a stormwater quality improvement project in the Kelsey Creek drainage basin and authorizing expenditures of said grant funds.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON, DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The City Manager or his designee is authorized to execute a contract to accept reimbursement grant funds from King County to assist with a stormwater quality improvement project in the Kelsey Creek drainage basin and authorizing expenditures of said grant funds, a copy of which contract shall be substantially in the form given Clerk's Receiving No. _____.

Section 2. The appropriate administrative officials of the City are hereby authorized to receive monies and to expend the same as authorized in said contract.

Section 3. The City Manager or his designee shall have responsibility for the administration of said grant monies and shall have all authority necessary to enter into agreements regarding the use thereof including consultant agreements to expend funds as provided in said grant agreement.

Section 4. The approximate amount and anticipated source of revenue for the grant proposal and acceptance is:

King County WaterWorks Grant Program	\$100,000
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Section 5. Upon execution of said contract, the budget for the Utilities D-109, Flood Control Capital Program shall be amended by appropriating revenues in the amount of the grant and acceptance herein authorized.

<u>Description</u>	<u>Amount Appropriated</u>
Stormwater Quality Retrofit in Kelsey Creek Program	\$100,000

Provided, however, if the actual revenue received from the anticipated source specified in said contract should be more or less than the anticipated amount set forth herein, the appropriation shall be adjusted to be equal to the amount actually received.

Section 6. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force five (5) days after its passage and legal publication.
