SUBJECT: City Fleet Ranking

We are pleased to announce that the National Association of Fleet Administrators has honored the City of Bellevue's fleet operations with a #2 ranking among the 100 Best Fleets in North America.

Bellevue's fleet operations has participated in the 100 Best Fleets program for seven consecutive years. Only four years ago, we were ranked #43 and have steadily moved the organization to better results, including a #7 ranking last year.

The 100 Best Fleets program recognizes peak performing fleet operations across North America. Each are evaluated by a panel of industry experts that base their assessments on competitive pricing, resource stewardship, turnaround times, maintenance quality, technology implementation, accountability, staff development, creativity, collaboration, and organizational culture.

To give context to the significance of Bellevue's ranking, several Washington State fleets were ranked among the 100 Best Fleets, including in ranked order:

#2 City of Bellevue

#55 Bonneville Power Administration#58 Chelan County PUD District 1#73 Thurston County#75 King County#84 University of Washington

The City has millions of dollars invested in the vehicles and equipment used by frontline operating departments including Police, Fire, Transportation, Utilities, Development Services, and Parks & Community Services to deliver services to citizens. The Fleet & Communications Division of the Civic Services Department acquires and maintains the vehicles and equipment that comprise the City of Bellevue's fleet. This #2 ranking highlights the division's continued high performance and effective stewardship in managing and maintaining these important assets.
