ORDINANCE NO. 6373

AN ORDINANCE 1) authorizing execution of a 2017 Washington State Military Department Public Assistance grant agreement (and supplements if necessary) with the Washington State Military Department (WSMD) and Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) to accept up to \$236,489 in grant funding for the repair or restoration of damaged city facilities for incident(s) occurring between January 30, 2017 and February 22, 2017; 2) amending the 2017-2018 Operating Grants, Donations and Special Reserves Fund adopted by Ordinance No. 6333 on December 5, 2016, as previously amended, to increase the appropriation by \$236,489 with the acceptance of the WSMD and FEMA grant; and 3) authorizing administrative officials to receive, and expend said funds as authorized in said Grant Agreement.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON, DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The City Manager or his designee is authorized to execute a 2017 Washington State Military Department Public Assistance grant agreement (and supplements if necessary) with the the Washington State Military Department (WSMD) and Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) to accept up to \$236,489 in grant funding for the repair or restoration of damaged city facilities for incident(s) occurring between January 30, 2017 and February 22, 2017, a copy of which grant agreement shall be given Clerk's Receiving No. _____.

Section 2. The appropriate administrative officials of the City are hereby authorized to receive monies and to expend the same as authorized in said grant agreement.

Section 3. The 2017-2018 Operating Grants, Donations and Special Reserves, adopted by Ordinance No. 6333 on December 5, 2016, as previously amended, is hereby further amended to increase the appropriation to said Fund by \$236,489 with the acceptance of the WSMD and FEMA grant.

Section 4. The approximate amount and source of revenue for the grant proposal and acceptance are:

Washington State, Military Department and Federal Emergency Management Agency	\$236,489
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Provided, however, if the actual revenue received from the source specified in said Grant Agreement should be more or less than the amount set forth herein, the appropriations shall be adjusted to equal the amount actually received.

Section 5. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force five (5) days after its passage and legal publication.
