A RESOLUTION authorizing execution of an interim Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) by and between the City and the International Brotherhood of Electrical Workers, Local 77 (IBEW), modifying pay provisions in the 2015-2018 IBEW Collective Bargaining Agreement to provide premium pay of seven and one-half percent (7.5%) for signal electricians holding a valid certificate of competency and meeting the minimum qualifications of an electrical inspector.
