

CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON

ORDINANCE NO. 6382

AN ORDINANCE amending the 2017-2018 General Fund Budget adopted on December 5, 2016, as previously amended, to increase the appropriation by \$384,481 due to increased funds received from the East Metro Training Group Interlocal Agencies and authorizing administrative officials to receive, and expend said funds on behalf of the East Metro Training Group (EMTG) to provide entry-level and on-going training to fire personnel with Bellevue Fire and the other eight (8) EMTG partners.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON, DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The City's 2017-2018 General Fund adopted by Ordinance No. 6333 on December 5, 2016, as previously amended, is hereby further amended to increase its appropriation for by \$384,481 due to increased funds received from the East Metro Training Group Interlocal Agencies to provide entry-level and on-going training to fire personnel with Bellevue Fire and the other eight (8) EMTG partners.

Provided, however, if the actual revenue received from the anticipated source should be more or less than the amount set forth herein, the appropriations shall be adjusted to equal the amount actually received.

Section 2. The City Manager or his designee is authorized to execute any necessary or appropriate supplemental agreements to accomplish the purposes stated herein.

Section 3. The appropriate administrative officials of the City shall have responsibility for the administration of said funds and shall have all authority necessary or appropriate to expend funds as authorized herein.

Section 4. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force five (5) days after its passage and legal publication.
