SUBJECT: Summary of Enforcement area Ordinances for Adoption

On Monday night several ordinances will be coming forward for Council action in response to Council direction over the past several months. Most recently, on October 23, 2017 Council directed staff to return with final action regarding changes to vehicle parking, illegal waste dumping and public camping. A brief description ordinances coming forward for action include:

- Regular Session Agenda Item 11(b); Ordinance No 6383, relating to parking, amends Section 11.23.020 of the Bellevue City Code regarding parking over 24 hours. This proposed Ordinance clarifies that vehicles must be moved to a different block every 24 hours.
- Regular Session Agenda Item 11(c); Ordinance No 6384, amending Section 24.06.130 of the Bellevue City Code, adopting a new Section 10.06.120 to the Bellevue City Code, relating to unlawful sewage disposal. This proposed Ordinance changes the disposal of waste into or onto public infrastructure into a criminal infraction.
- Regular Session Agenda Item 11(d); Ordinance No 6385, repealing Section 3.43.040 of the Bellevue City Code, adopting a new Section 10.06.110 to the Bellevue City Code extending the prohibition against public camping to all City owned property and public easements.
