

CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON

ORDINANCE NO. 6414

AN ORDINANCE 1) authorizing execution of an Amended and Restated Interlocal Agreement (and supplements if necessary) with the King County Metro (KCM) for acceptance of \$250,000 in pass-through grant funds from KCM for Phase II of the Bellevue SchoolPool program; and 2) amending the 2017-2018 Operating Grants, Donations and Special Reserves Fund by increasing the appropriation by \$250,000.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON, DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The City Manager or his designee is authorized to execute an Amended and Restated Interlocal Agreement (and supplements if necessary) with King County Metro (KCM) for acceptance of \$250,000 in pass-through grant funds from KCM for Phase II of the Bellevue SchoolPool program, a copy of which Agreement shall be substantially in the form given Clerk's Receiving No. _____.

Section 2. The appropriate administrative officials of the City are hereby authorized to receive monies and to expend the same as authorized in said Agreement.

Section 3. The City Manager or his designee shall have responsibility for the administration of said funds and expenditure of said funds received pursuant to said Agreement and shall have all authority necessary to enter into agreements regarding the use thereof.

Section 4. The approximate amount and anticipated source of revenue for said grant monies is:

CMAQ Community Trip Reduction Initiative Grant	\$250,000
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Section 5. Upon execution of said Interlocal Agreement, the budget for the 2017-2018 Operating Grants, Donations and Special Reserves Fund shall be amended by increasing the appropriation by \$250,000 to said fund.

Provided, however, if the actual revenue received from the anticipated sources specified in said Interlocal Agreement shall be more or less than the anticipated amount set forth herein, the appropriations shall be adjusted to be equal to the amount actually received.

Section 6. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force five (5) days after its passage and legal publication.
