EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

This Resolution authorizes execution of a five-year Interlocal Agreement for waterfowl management.

RECOMMENDATION

BACKGROUND/ANALYSIS

Since 1987, the City of Bellevue has actively participated in the Seattle Metropolitan Waterfowl Management Committee. This Committee, comprised of local government agencies and private companies, provides direct financial support to the USDA Wildlife Services Agency to achieve the regional goals of the Committee.

The purpose of this Interlocal Agreement is to provide joint funding for an egg addling program and population monitoring and census, primarily of Canada geese, within King and Snohomish County. This program will assist in communicating, maintaining, and managing both public and approved private site impacts of excessive waterfowl.

POLICY & FISCAL IMPACTS**Policy Impact**

This agreement provides for continued regional cooperative efforts to control waterfowl populations, provide public and agency education, and population data collection.

Fiscal Impact

This agreement will obligate the City to the amount of \$2,200 for 2019 with an amount not to exceed \$13,320, plus all applicable taxes, for the five-year term. Over the subsequent four years, the amount the City is obligated to contribute could increase or decrease approximately 5 percent depending on the number of participating cities and organizations.

There are sufficient funds budgeted in the 2019-2020 Parks and Community Services Department Operating Budget for the first two years of the agreement. Future costs associated with this agreement will be requested in subsequent operating budgets and will be subject to final budget appropriation.

OPTIONS

1.
