EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

This motion will award Bid No. 19023 to Active Construction, Inc. for the 150th Avenue SE/SE Newport Way to SE 38th Street – Roadway Improvements.

RECOMMENDATION

BACKGROUND/ANALYSIS

150th Avenue SE Rockery Replacement

The City of Bellevue has over 600 rockeries within the City Limits. An inventory and evaluation of the Eastgate Annexation area was conducted in 2016 following the annexation of the Eastgate area in 2012. One hundred and five new rockeries were identified during this inventory. This process revealed 20 rockeries that needed further geotechnical evaluation.

In June 2017, the City contracted with Klienfelder Inc., to evaluate the condition of the 20 rockeries. The evaluation concluded that the rockery along 150th Avenue SE was the top priority for replacement. The replacement priority was determined based on the condition of the rockeries and public safety.

On December 3, 2018, Council approved Ordinance No. 6445 adopting the 2019-2025 CIP which included the Major Maintenance Program (CIP Plan No. PW-M-19). Ordinance No. 6445 included an increase in the appropriation by \$1,200,000 for maintenance work in the Eastgate Annexation Area, funded by annexation sales tax revenue provided through the State of Washington. This program is intended to address maintenance needs, such as walkway failures, electrical upgrades and other safety repair work that exceed the financial capacity of the Transportation Department's operating budget.

The 150th Avenue SE/SE Newport Way to SE 38th Street – Roadway Improvements project will replace 800 feet of existing rockery with an engineered gravity block wall within the project limits. In addition to replacing the rockery, the adjacent cement concrete curb and asphalt path will be replaced with a new cement concrete curb, gutter, and sidewalk.

150th Avenue SE at SE Newport Way (adding 600-foot southbound to westbound right-turn lane)

On November 8, 2016, Bellevue voters approved a proposition to fund transportation neighborhood safety, connectivity and congestion improvements. The Neighborhood Safety, Connectivity and Congestion Levy included voter approved funding for six main focus areas including neighborhood congestion reduction, safety, sidewalks, bicycle facilities, intelligent transportation systems (ITS), and maintenance.

In prioritizing the neighborhood congestion reduction projects at the January 12, 2017 Transportation Commission meeting, staff presented several congestion reduction projects in the Eastgate area. A project to add a southbound to westbound right-turn lane at the intersection of 150th Avenue SE and SE Newport Way was identified as one of the highest priority projects, as this project would alleviate the ongoing congestion that occurs during peak traffic hours in the Eastgate area.

On September 5, 2017, Council adopted Resolution No. 9302 to develop preliminary design for the improvements on 150th Avenue SE at SE Newport Way and at SE 37th Street, as part of the Neighborhood Congestion Management (Levy) Program (CIP Plan No. PW-R-198).

On June 4, 2018, Council adopted Resolution No. 9418 to develop final design for improvements at the 150th Avenue SE and SE Newport Way intersection, as part of the Neighborhood Congestion Management (Levy) Program (CIP Plan No. PW-R-198).

On December 3, 2018, Council adopted the 2019-2025 Capital Investment Program (CIP) (Ordinance No. 6445) that included the 150th Avenue SE at SE Newport Way Project (CIP Plan No. PW-R-202) and Neighborhood Congestion Management (Levy) Program (CIP Plan No. PW-R-198) to fund the design and construction of a 600-foot southbound to westbound right-turn lane at the intersection of 150th Avenue SE and SE Newport Way.

Fiscal Impact

Design of this project was fully funded by the Neighborhood Congestion Management Levy program (CIP Plan No. PW-R-198). The Neighborhood Congestion Management Levy program (CIP Plan No. PW-R-198) fund will not be used to construct the project. Awarding this bid will obligate the City to \$2,709,933.00, plus all applicable taxes, to replace existing rockery with an engineered gravity block wall along the east side of 150th Avenue SE between SE Newport Way and SE 38th Street (CIP Plan No. PW-M-19) and to add a 600-foot long southbound to westbound right-turn lane at the intersection of 150th Avenue SE and SE Newport Way (CIP No. PW-R-202). This amount is approximately 14 percent under the Engineer's Estimate. Sufficient funding exists in the 2019-2025 CIP (CIP Plans Nos. PW-M-19 and PW-R-202) to fully fund this construction contract:
