EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

This agreement provides ongoing licensing and support for the GIS software that is used to provide geographic services to City staff and the public.

BACKGROUND/ANALYSIS

The City has utilized GIS services for a wide variety of planning and operational needs for many years. GIS is used by the Council and every department as an effective tool for short- and long-term comprehensive planning related to transportation, utilities, parks, and public safety. Mapping and analysis have been important tools in municipal operations as well. The City's use of GIS has expanded to include intelligent, online/mobile map-based solutions to assist the public and for applications to improve field operations for staff. An example is the use of GIS software to assist Council in the analysis of potential sites for homeless shelters in Bellevue, the Tech Startup web map, and the FEMA Floodplain Report certification.

Most recently Council approved an Enterprise License Agreement in 2016. No other vendor is able to provide the level of services, software, and support that ESRI does. As a result, a Competitive Exception form was completed. By entering into this three-year agreement, the City will continue to receive the following benefits:

- Unlimited number of mapping software licenses available for staff. Today we have approximately 205 staff using desktop mapping software.
- Unlimited number of licenses for extensions such as Spatial Analysis tools which provide tools for staff to analyze data and identify solutions.
- Unlimited use of software allowing the City to build and deploy web and mobile mapping solutions for staff, residents, and contractors.
- Maintenance on all ESRI software deployed by the City.
- A subscription to ESRI's cloud allowing the City to host web/mobile mapping solutions such as data collection apps for field crews to update and maintain data.

• A robust training program for staff, and technical support for all the products and services covered under this agreement.

POLICY & FISCAL IMPACTS

Policy Impact

City contracting policies.

- Bellevue City Code 4.28.040 authorizes the purchase of material, supplies, and equipment in excess of \$90,000 with Council approval.
- Bellevue City Code 4.28.130 authorizes the City to make open market purchases of materials, supplies, and equipment and to procure services without obtaining competitive bids or quotations as otherwise required under BCC 4.28.040 and 4.28.050 when the best interests of the City would be served thereby.

Fiscal Impact

This Resolution authorizes the City to enter into the enterprise licensing agreement with ESRI for a fixed contract amount of \$104,300 for the first year and \$101,800 each year for the remaining years, plus all applicable taxes, over the three-year life of the agreement (\$307,900 total). Funding for this agreement was planned for and included in the adopted 2019-20 budget for the Information Technology Department. Future funding will be requested as part of the 2021-2022 budget process.
