BACKGROUND & ANALYSIS

The Utilities Stream Team Program Administrator will present information about the Peamouth Patrol Volunteer Monitoring program, including an update on recent events observing the peamouth migration up Kelsey Creek by the Wilburton trestle.

The Stream Team provides a volunteer program and community education and outreach for stormwater. Education and outreach efforts include a wide range of activities including working with schools and community groups, producing brochures, and creating pollution prevention campaigns.

The Stream Team fulfills Utilities Strategic Plan goals and meets requirements under the Phase II National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System Municipal Stormwater Permit, and Lake Washington/Cedar/Sammamish Watershed Recovery Plan recommendations. Program elements evolve and adapt over time, but the mission has remained the same: to provide information, increase community involvement and awareness, and initiate changes that will protect the quality of our water systems and fish/wildlife habitat.
