ACTION ITEM

Resolution approving the King County 2019 Comprehensive Solid Waste Management Plan: King County Solid Waste Division staff will provide an overview of the King County 2019 Comprehensive Solid Waste Management Plan (Plan), including amendments adopted by the County Council after the last Bellevue Council briefing on February 25. The Plan outlines goals and policies for managing solid waste in King County over the next six years, including recommendations on potential future disposal methods, new transfer facilities, and recycling goals.

The Plan was adopted by the King County Council on April 24. In order for the Plan to be forwarded to the state Department of Ecology for final action, cities representing 75 percent of the total population of cities acting on the Plan within the 120-day review period must approve the Plan. The review period ends on September 16.

Staff is seeking Council action on a Resolution to approve the Plan. Council may also reject the Plan or choose not to act on the Plan.
