- * Analysis of health and human services trends and issues that affect the quality of life of Bellevue residents
- * Forecasting of "most likely future": how can the City best prepare for changes in human services in a quickly changing environment?

Purpose of the Needs Update

- * Guide the recommendations for allocation of 2021-2022 Human Services Fund/Community Development Block Grant by the Human Services Commission to the City Council
- * Direct work of Human Services Division staff
- * Provide information for other City departments, community groups, agencies and regional planning efforts
