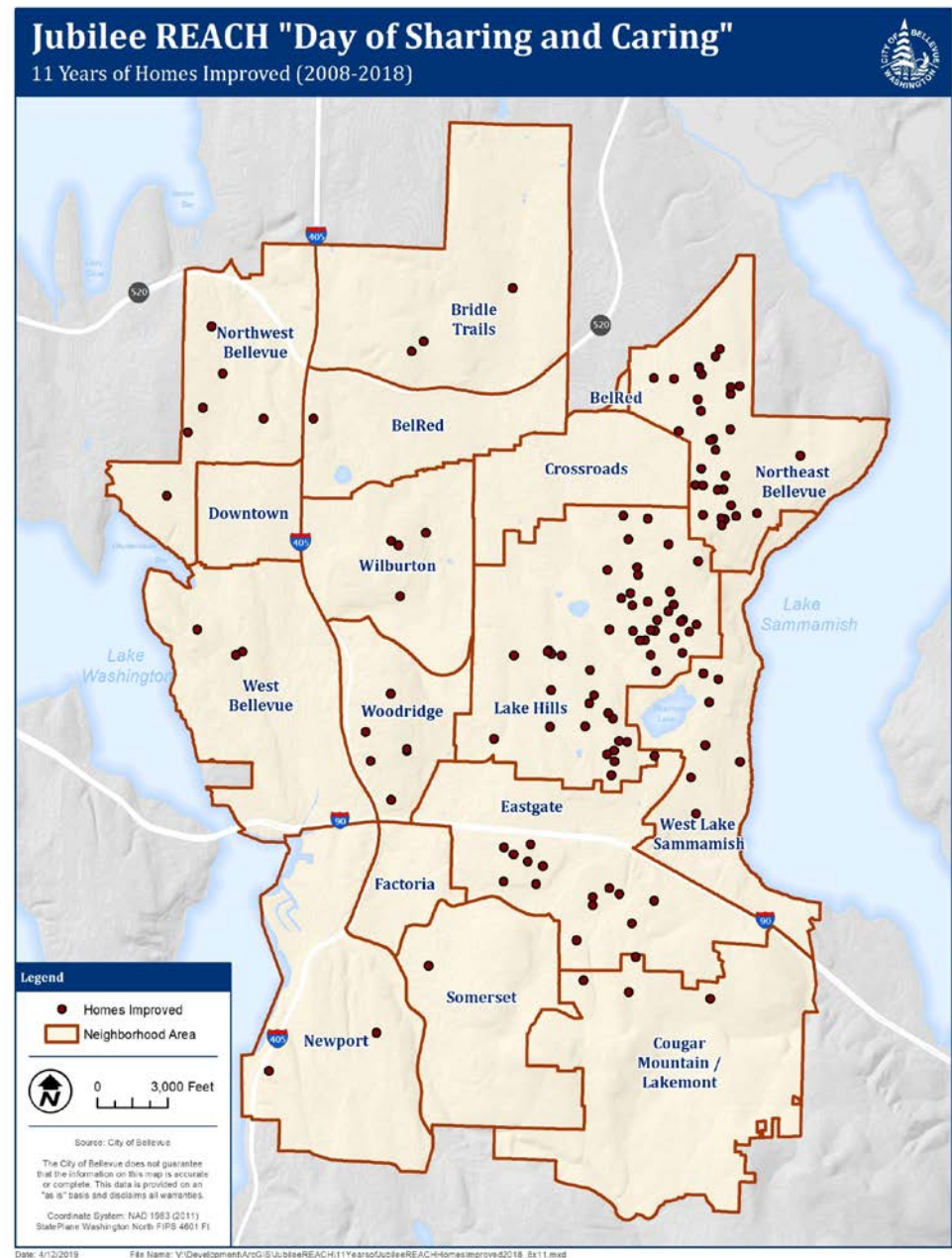
Program Purpose

Jubilee REACH and the City of Bellevue recognize a mutual community-based interest in addressing the needs of Bellevue property owners who are unable to maintain their homes due to economic and physical limitations. To assist homeowners, Jubilee REACH and the City mutually agree to work together to assist Jubilee REACH in matching community resources and volunteers with individual homeowners and their specific projects.



Day of Sharing and Caring began in 2008, with a goal of assisting 15-40 homeowners per year.

Since 2008, 163+ homes have been improved.

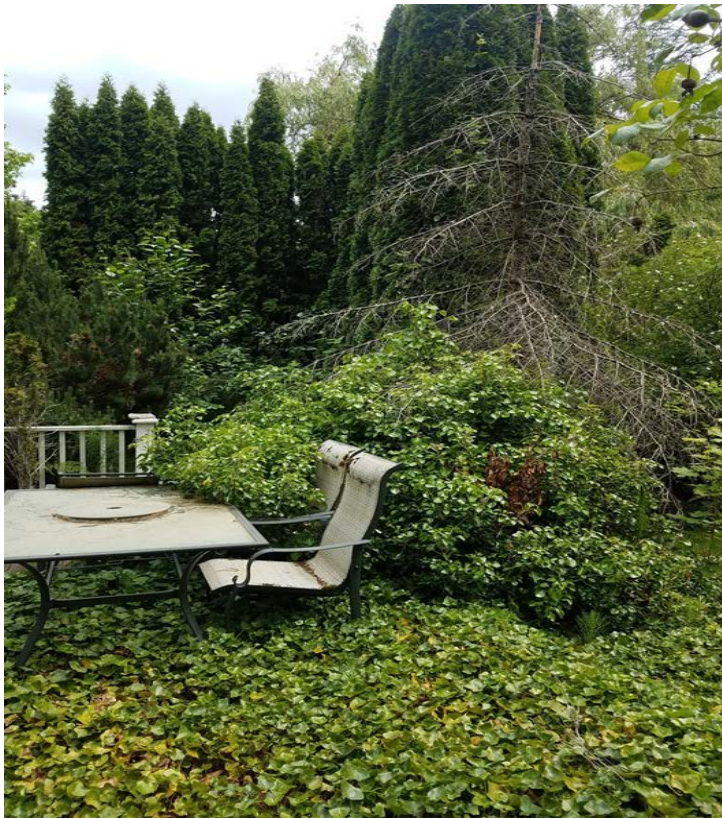
