Next Steps – Lincoln Center

- Demolition Permit
 - Issued June 12
- Building Permit
 - Ongoing coordination
 - Target issuance end of June
- Utility Permit
 - Ongoing coordination
 - Target issuance mid-June
- Construction Complete November
- Operational Costs Determination/Discussion

Next Steps - Land Use Process

- Temporary Public Safety Facility (LUC 20.20.850)
- City Manager declaration of emergency
- Application for approval of Temporary Public Safety Facility (exempt from other land use processes)
- Maximum of 3 years (2-years with an allowance for one-year extension)
- Timing depends upon date when Lincoln Center commences year-round shelter services



Update – Bridge Location

- Working with property owner lease/sublease agreements
- Staff review: building, fire, public safety
- Community engagement
- CFH staffing needs
- August occupancy
- Operational costs determination/discussion
