

Process for Interim Official Control

- Council adopted Ordinance 6368 on August 7, 2017.
- The Ordinance imposes an "interim official control" under the GMA, which is effective for six months.
- The Interim Official Control may be renewed for additional six-month periods, if a public hearing is held.
- The public hearing tonight satisfies the requirements under the GMA to extend the Interim Official Control for an additional six-month period.

Recap of Interim Regulations under Ordinance 6368

- Defines Permanent Homeless Shelter as a land use classification in the LUC.
- Allows homeless shelter uses in all districts where Hotel/Motel uses are allowed.
- Requires application of the Conditional Use provisions in LUC Part 20.30B and the general development requirements to establish a homeless shelter use in districts where they are allowed.

- If Council approves the extension, the EBCC will hold a public hearing on the extension on February 6.
- Substantive work to develop permanent regulations regarding homeless shelters is planned for this year.
