

CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON

ORDINANCE NO. 6474

AN ORDINANCE 1) authorizing execution of a grant agreement with the State of Washington Recreation and Conservation Office (RCO) to accept \$265,000 in grant funds; 2) amending the 2019-2020 General Capital Investment Program (CIP) to increase the appropriation by \$265,000; and 3) amending the 2019-2025 CIP Plan to increase the budget for the Parks Renovation & Refurbishment Plan (CIP P-R-11) by \$265,000 to assist with the cost of replacing the synthetic turf and track surface at Wilburton Hill Park.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON, DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The City Manager or his designee is authorized to execute a grant agreement with the State of Washington Recreation and Conservation Office (RCO) to accept \$265,000 in grant funds, a copy of which grant agreement shall be substantially in the form given Clerk's Receiving No. _____.

Section 2. The appropriate administrative officials of the City are hereby authorized to receive monies and to expend the same as authorized in said grant agreement.

Section 3. The City Manager or his designee shall have responsibility for the administration of said funds and expenditure of said funds received pursuant to said grant agreement and shall have all authority necessary to enter into agreements regarding the use thereof.

Section 4. The 2019-2020 General Capital Investment Program (CIP), adopted by Ordinance No. 6445 on December 3, 2018, as previously amended, is hereby further amended to increase the appropriation by \$265,000.

Section 5. The 2019-2025 CIP Plan adopted by Ordinance No. 6445 on December 3, 2018, as previously amended, is hereby further amended to increase the budget for the Parks Renovation & Refurbishment Plan (CIP P-R-11) by \$265,000 to assist with the cost of replacing the synthetic turf and track surface at Wilburton Hill Park.

Section 6. If the actual revenue received from the State of Washington Recreation and Conservation Office (RCO) shall be more or less than the

anticipated amount set forth herein, the appropriations to the CIP Fund and Plan shall be adjusted to be equal to the amount actually received.

Section 7. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force five (5) days after its passage and legal publication.
