

CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON

RESOLUTION NO. 9657

A RESOLUTION determining that an existing water line easement located at 221 140th Ave NE is surplus to the City's needs and is no longer required for providing continued public utility service; and setting a time and place for a hearing to consider the release of this easement.

WHEREAS, on August 19, 1963, King County Water District No. 99 was granted a water line easement on the property located at 221 140th Ave NE in Bellevue, Washington, bearing King County Recording Number 5628985; and

WHEREAS, in the 1970's, Bellevue assumed King County Water District No. 99 including all assets, real property and easements; and

WHEREAS, the owner of the property subject to the easement, has requested the City release the existing water line easement bearing King County Recording Number 5628985 (as depicted on Attachment A) because it interferes with the development of the property and a replacement easement has been granted; and

WHEREAS, the Bellevue Utility Department has verified and confirmed that the aforementioned water line easement is no longer required to provide continued public utility services; and

WHEREAS, based on the foregoing, the existing water line easement (as depicted on Attachment A) is no longer needed by the City and is otherwise surplus property interests; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Bellevue City Code 4.32.070 and RCW 35.94.040, the City Council desires to set a time and place for a public hearing to consider the release of said easement; now, therefore,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON, DOES
RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Pursuant to Bellevue City Code 4.32.070 and RCW 35.94.040, the City Council of the City of Bellevue does hereby declare the existing water line easement bearing King County Recording Number 5628985 (as depicted on Attachment A) as surplus to the needs of the City.

Section 2. A public hearing shall be held upon the proposal to release the easement set forth in Section 1, on November 4, 2019 at 8:00 pm or as soon

thereafter as the matter may be heard by the City Council, at Bellevue City Hall, 450 110th Avenue NE, Bellevue, Washington.
