Design Alternative Start: January 2016

Outstanding Issues: Design Feedback, potential funding shortfall



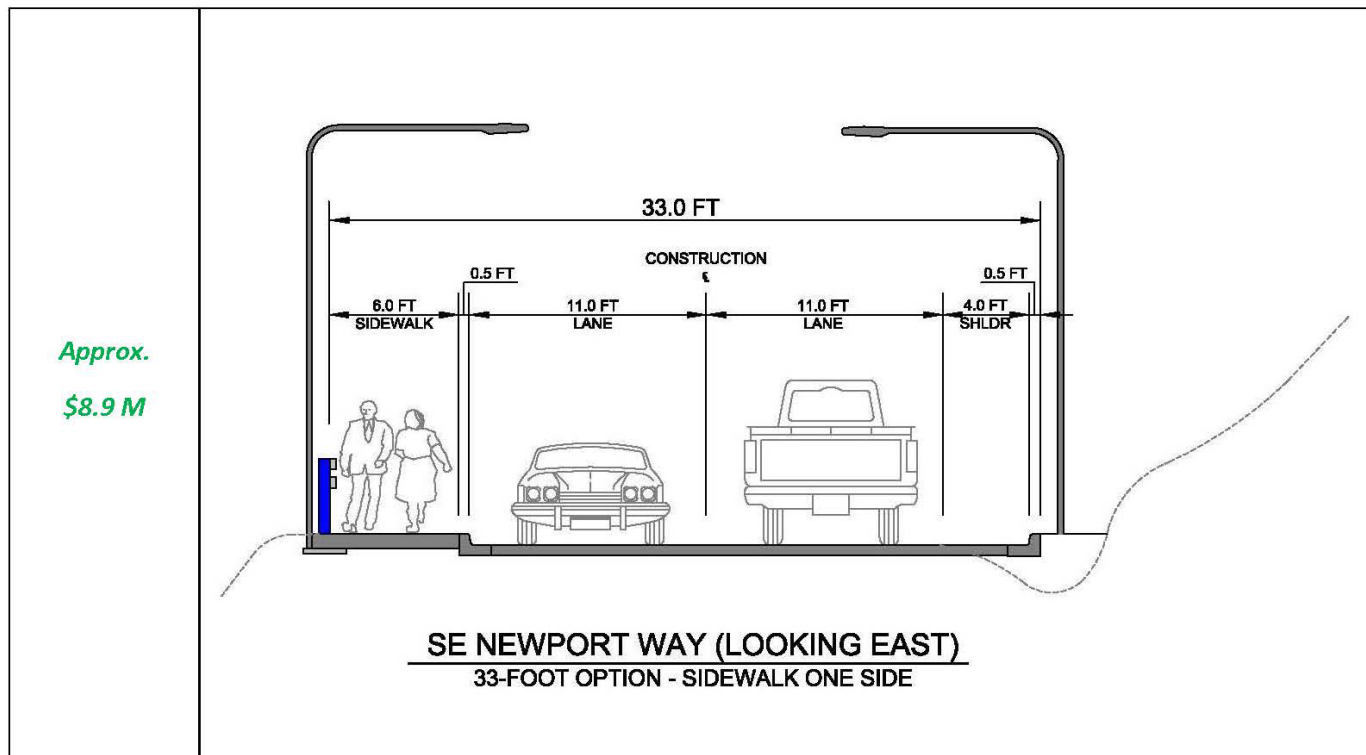

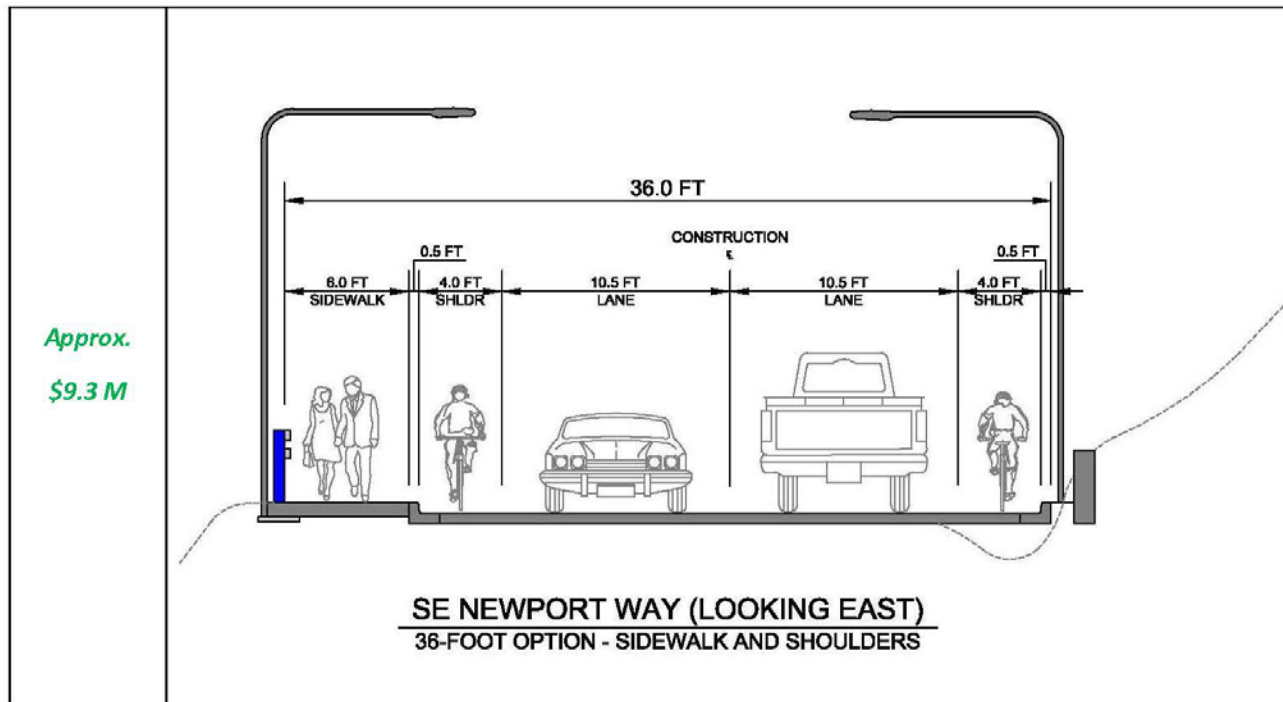

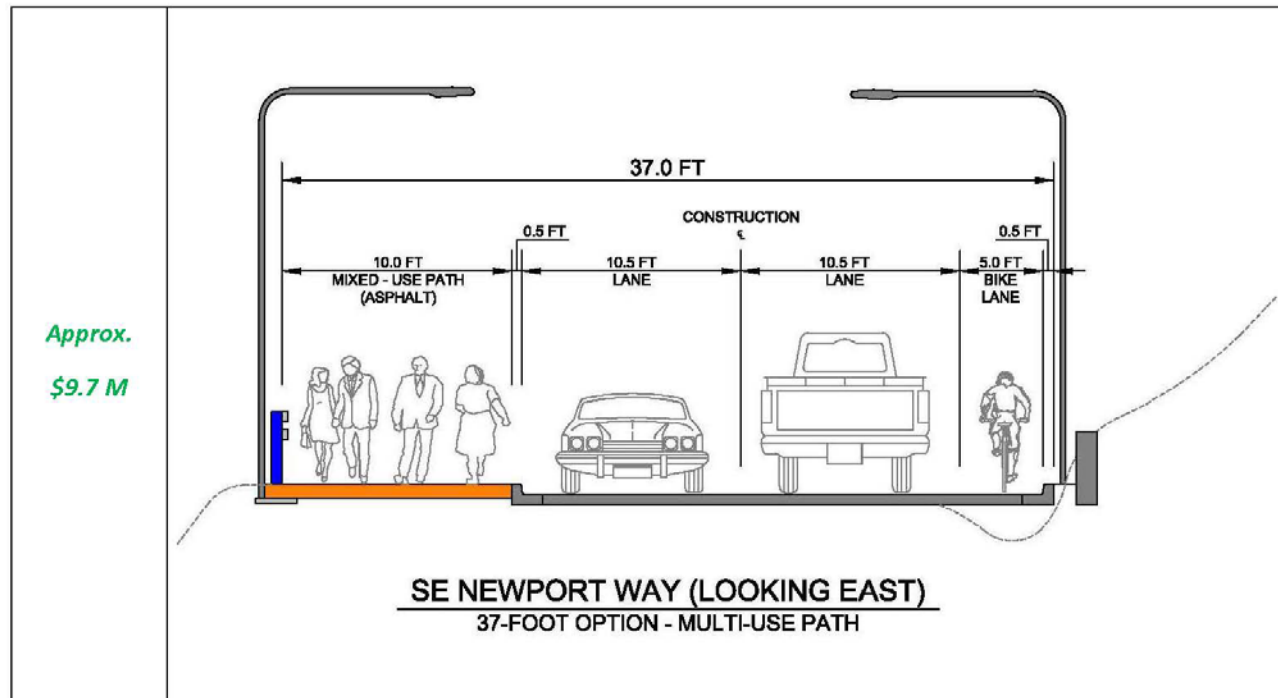

37 FT OPTION MULTI-USE PATH



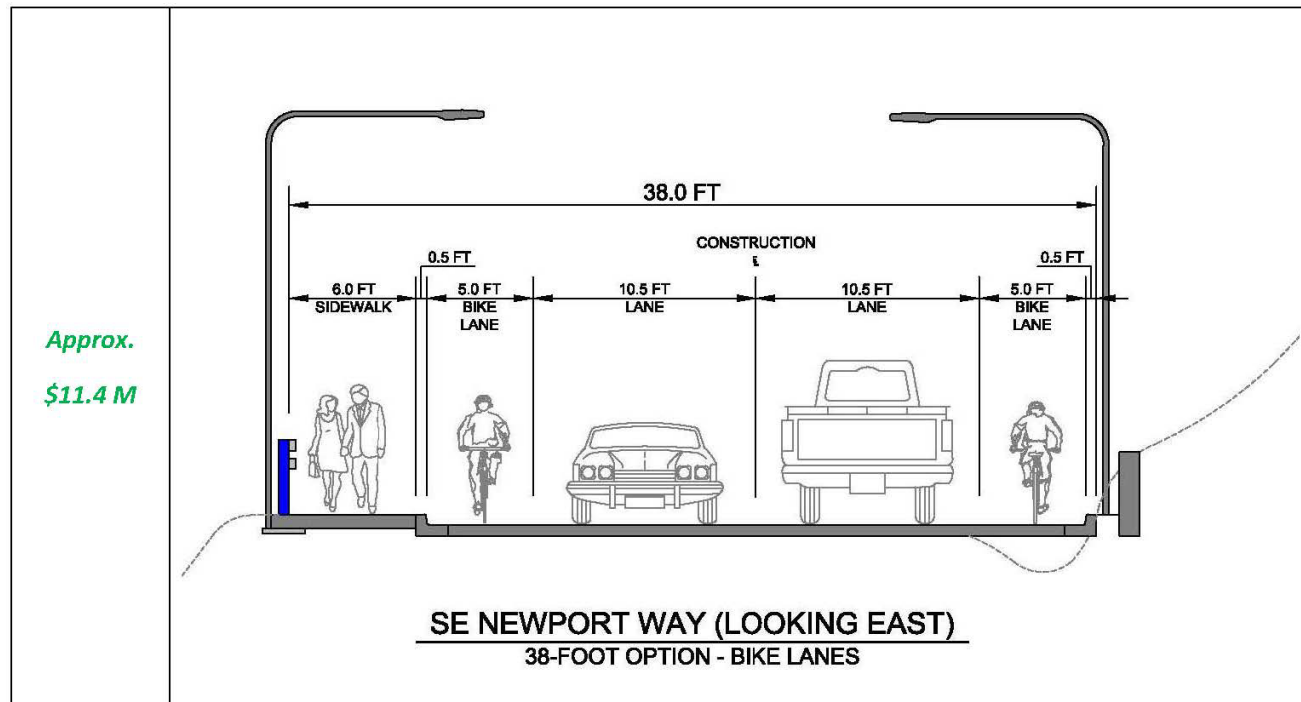

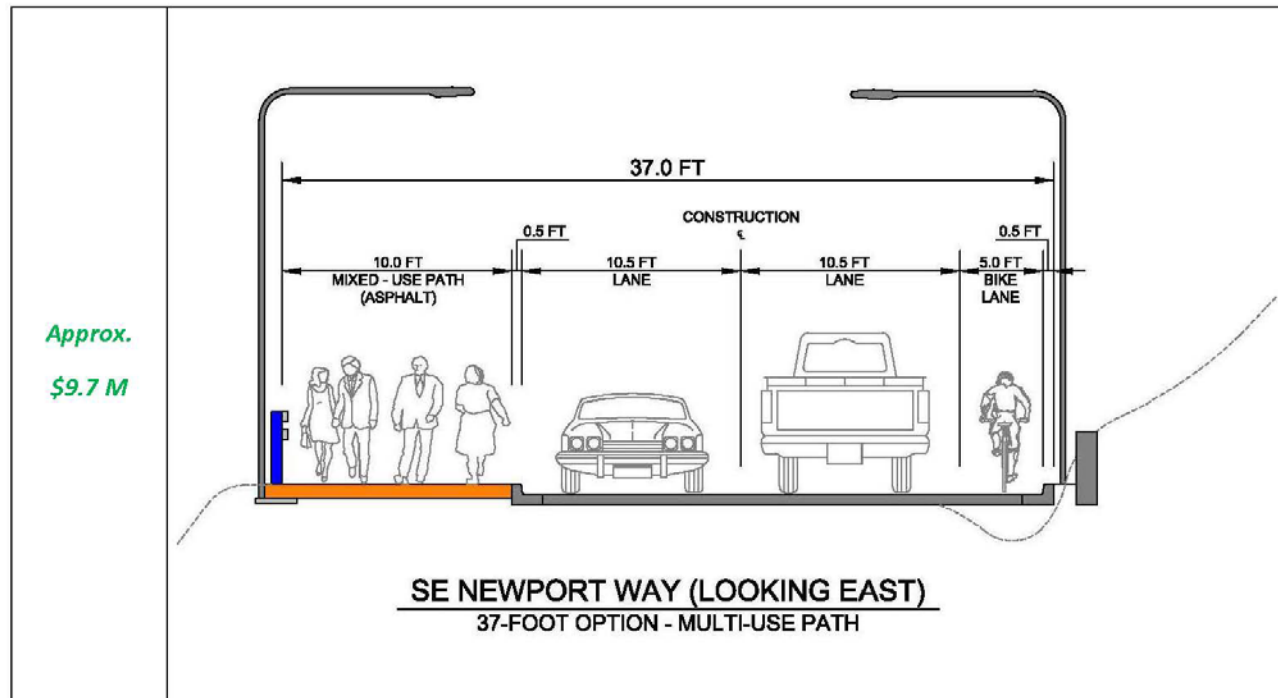
