Main Topics Addressed in Conditional Approval

Required Changes (attachment B) -


- 1. SMP Authority: Clarification on Critical Areas Ordinance integration
- 2. Nonconforming Regulations: Clarifications for internal consistency
- 3. Development Regulations: OHWM reference and Residential clarifications
- 4. Shoreline Modifications: Changes pier standards and stabilization thresholds related to statewide interest and regional consistency
- 5. Permit & Decisions: Clarification related to administrative provisions.

Developing Alternatives

Parameters for developing alternatives

- Alternatives can be proposed for "required" or "recommended" changes.
- Alternatives need to be consistent with the "...purpose and intent of Ecology's original change" pursuant to RCW 90.58.090 (2) (e) (ii).
- Other "non-substantive" corrections can also be included in the City's response to Ecology.
- Ecology and City must agree on all alternatives before final approval
