




- 94% of residents believe the overall quality of life in Bellevue exceeds or greatly exceeds their expectations.

How would you rate the overall quality of services provided by the City of Bellevue?




- 92% of residents believe the overall quality of city services exceeds or greatly exceeds their expectations.

Value of Services for Tax Dollar Paid (n=511)




 77% of residents believe that Bellevue is headed in the right direction.




- 97% of residents say that Bellevue is a good or excellent place to live.
