Public Camping

Vehicle Parking Enforcement 2017 Update

- Approx. 75 parking complaints per month
- About 15% concern vehicle residences
- 75% of vehicle residence situations result in additional future parking complaints
- On average, impound 7 vehicles monthly;
 1 vehicle (or less) is a vehicle residence
- 35 vehicle residencies (one night count October 2017)

Vehicle Residency Existing Process

- Complaint based
- Coordinated response
- Officer/outreach offer services
- Additional contact
- Noticing and authorized vehicle removal

Vehicle Residency/Public Camping Legal Background

- 4th Amendment
 - Reasonable search and seizure
- 14th Amendment
 - Due process
 - Fundamental right to travel
- 8th Amendment
 - Cruel and unusual punishment

Vehicle Parking Existing Codes

- Constitutional limitations
- Civil infraction framework
- BCC 11.23.010 Residential parking zones
- BCC 11.23.020 No parking in the same public space for period exceeding 24hours
- BCC 11.23.022 Time limit zones

Vehicle Parking Code Changes Recommendation (First Phase)

- Modify 24 hour parking code to state relocation to a different named street
- Continue with coordinated response encountering vehicle residencies
- Public education regarding code changes

Follow-up

- Education campaign about new requirements for movement (citywide)
- Pro-active outreach in "hot spot" areas to provide relief
- Monitor impact over time
- Reevaluate Parking Regulations if needed

Vehicle Parking Code Changes And Additional Options

- Parking regulations/restrictions for oversized vehicles/RVs (location, time of day).
- 2. Permit for all oversized vehicles/RVs in public rights of way (specified streets).
- Parking regulations for RV/car campers (Los Angeles)
- 4. Permit requirements for RV/car campers

Additional Tool Illegal Waste Dumping

- Illegal waste dumping
 - Existing code civil violation
 - Change to a criminal offense
 - Educational information on proper disposal

Vehicle Parking Recommendations

Modify city code language regarding:

- Modify 24 hour parking code to state relocation to a different named street
- Change improper waste dumping to a criminal offense

Public Camping

- January through August 2017
 - 7 trespass notices given
 - 3 trespass notices served
 - 24 encampment clean-ups
- Current process
 - Outreach (offer services)
 - Additional outreach if necessary
 - Site clean up
- Recommend extending prohibition against camping to all city owned property and public easements
