Federal Transportation Funds Administered by PSRC





Specific criteria & procedures for designation as regional center


Transportation funds dedicated to regional centers



Current Countywide Centers

Transportation funds allocated to counties for local projects.

NO specific criteria or procedures for designation as countywide center.



CENTERS FRAMEWORK UPDATE:

Proposal

- Existing regional centers retain designations
 - 2 types of growth centers
 - 2 types of MIC
- Retains some requirements & increases others
- More places will be eligible for regional designation – (military, MIC)
- Establishes basic, common criteria for countywide designation

CENTERS FRAMEWORK UPDATE:

Bellevue's Interests

- Downtown Bellevue retains regional center designation (new type: Metro)
- BelRed may be eligible for regional center designation
- Other places may be eligible for countywide designation (e.g. Factoria, Crossroads, Wilburton)
- Establish clear, measurable and reasonably high requirements – prevent proliferation of centers, maintain value of designation
