

- 1<sup>st</sup> community college to offer baccalaureates – more than any other in the community and technical college system








- Open access

Impact on local commerce and economic health

- 172 million into the East King County economy each year
- 116.5 million in direct contributions
- 55.4 million in indirect contributions





- FY 2015-2016 budget
- Grounds approx. 131 acres
  - 100 main, 20 East Campus, Sunset Ranch, North Campus
  - Buildings approx. 900,000 square feet
- Average of 1,600 employees at any given time and put \$52 million into the local economy (gross payroll multiplier)





Impact on local workforce

- 11,000 students trained annually in high demand job skills
- Increased health science training programs
- 80% of BC prof-tech graduates are employed in King County




## Under Pevelopment


