## **CDBG** Requirements

- Project must be located in Bellevue
- Funds must be spent in a timely manner
- No more than 1.5 x the annual budget amount in HUD account at end of year

### **Human Services Fund**

- 97 applications received
- \$4.4 million in requests
- \$3.4 million available budget
- \$1 million more requested than available

## Overarching Issues

- 1. Affordable housing for low and moderate income residents
- 2. Support as population of older adults increases and people with disabilities live longer
- Expanded culturally and linguistically appropriate services as Bellevue becomes increasingly diverse
- 4. Improved transportation to access human services and employment opportunities

## **Total 2017 Funding Recommended**

Human Services Fund: \$3,431,425 Estimated CDBG Funds\* <u>923,147</u> \$4,354,572

Includes estimated entitlement amount, program income and unspent prior year funds
