## CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON

## ORDINANCE NO. 6477

AN ORDINANCE 1) authorizing execution of a four-year interlocal agreement (and supplements if necessary) with the Washington State Department of Transportation (WSDOT) to accept up to \$409,892 of state funds to support the City's Commute Trip Reduction (CTR) program; 2) amending the 2019-2020 Operating Grants, Donations and Special Reserves Fund to increase the appropriation by \$204,946; and, 3) authorizing execution of an interlocal agreement (and supplements if necessary) with King County Metro (KCM) in an amount up to \$240,184 for CTR services at CTR-affected employer worksites and at Transportation Management Program (TMP)-affected building sites.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON, DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The City Manager or his designee is authorized to execute a fouryear interlocal agreement (and supplements if necessary) with the Washington State Department of Transportation (WSDOT) to accept up to \$409,892 of state funds to support the City's Commute Trip Reduction (CTR) program, a copy of which interlocal agreement shall be substantially in the form given Clerk's Receiving No.

Section 2. The appropriate administrative officials of the City are hereby authorized to receive monies and to expend the same as authorized in said interlocal agreement.

Section 3. At the time of execution of said Interlocal Agreement and acceptance of said funds, a project shall be established within the Operating Grants, Donations and Special Reserves Fund, into which all said respective funds shall be deposited.

Section 4. The City Manager or his designee shall have responsibility for the administration of said funds and shall have all authority necessary to enter into agreements regarding the use thereof to expend funds as provided in the Interlocal Agreement.

Section 5. The approximate amount and anticipated source of revenue for said funds is:

Washington State Department of Transportation \$409,892

Section 6. Upon execution of said Interlocal Agreement, the budget for the 2019-2020 Operating Grants, Donations and Special Reserves Fund shall be amended by appropriating \$204,946 to said fund.

Provided, however, if the actual revenue received from the anticipated source specified in said Interlocal Agreement shall be more or less than the anticipated amount set forth herein, the appropriation shall be adjusted to equal the amount actually received.
