Recent CDBG Funding History

2019: \$764,373

2018: \$754,998

2017: \$685,152

2016: \$635,872

(2020 funding is expected
to be similar to 2019)



Program Income History

Loan repayments from the Major Home Repair Program are *program income* and can be used for CDBG eligible activities.

2019:	\$181,072 (as of 10/28/19)
2018:	\$241,170
2017:	\$438,807
2016:	\$316,401
2015:	\$385,600



CDBG Requirements

- Must benefit predominately low- and moderate-income residents.
- Projects must be located in Bellevue and/or serve Bellevue residents.
- Funds must be spent in a timely manner.



2020 CDBG Funding Process

- Six applications were received.
- Two Human Services Commission meetings were held to review applications.
- Public hearing was held on July 16, 2019.
