SUBJECT: Temporary Encampment Land Use Code Amendment

The Bellevue City Council is scheduled to conduct a Public Hearing on November 18 to receive public comment on development of a Temporary Encampment Land Use Code Amendment (LUCA) which is authorized to update Chapter 20.30U Land Use Code (LUC), which covers permitting of temporary encampments hosted by religious organizations on their property. This LUCA is intended to eliminate the need to refer to both Chapter 20.30U LUC and the provisions of an existing Consent Decree when administering temporary encampments in the City. It is intended to result in greater consistency, predictability and ease of implementation for future temporary encampments in the City.

Final action by the City Council is tentatively scheduled for December 9. Final action before the EBCC is scheduled for January 7, 2020, to approve/disapprove the final ordinance that will be adopted by the City Council. A copy of the Temporary encampment Staff Report with attachments is included in preparation for the Courtesy Public Hearing scheduled before the EBCC on November 13.
