DISCUSSION/ACTION ITEMS

Preview of Regional Issues for 2020: Staff will provide a memo tonight for Council that gives a preview of Regional issues anticipated to be in play in 2020. Typically, the month of January is when many regional agencies and other bodies reorganize their agendas to include new work items, on-board newly-elected officials and restructure committee membership. Staff is collecting the work plans and issues lists of the various regional committees to ensure Councilmembers representing Bellevue have up to date information.
