

"The federal government should set standards for the issuance of birth certificates and sources of identification, such as driver's licenses."



Background

- Congress passed the REAL ID Act in 2005
- Starting October 1, 2020, REAL ID compliant documents are required for:
 - Domestic air travel (18 years old and older)
 - Access to restricted federal facilities (e.g. military bases)





REAL ID compliant documents

You may already have what you need for October 1,

2020 If you have one of the following:



- Foreign passport
- Federally recognized, tribal-issued photo ID
- · Permanent resident card
- U.S. Department of Defense ID (military ID)
- DHS trusted traveler cards
- Enhanced driver's license or ID card
- U.S. Employment Authorization Card (I-766)

State-issued compliant documents

Washington's state-issued **REAL ID compliant** documents are the Enhanced driver license and ID card (EDL/EID)

Requirements - Proof of citizenship, identity, social security number and residency








State-issued non-compliant documents

Washington state **standard** driver license or ID card

Requirements - Proof of identity and Washington residency







Marking on standard documents

Standard driver licenses and ID cards have the words "FEDERAL LIMITS APPLY."

Marking differentiates from REAL ID compliant cards. Not an indication of citizenship or immigration status.






Washington state approach

Choose the type of identification that works best for you!

Standard Driver License/ID



- ID 2020 campaign uses mix of media and methods in multiple languages:
