SUBJECT: City of Bellevue COVID – 19 Response Summary

Mayor Robinson issued an emergency proclamation on March 3, positioning the City to move quickly to respond to the potential spread of COVID – 19. Since that time, the City has instituted measures to comply with recommendations from Public Health – Seattle & King County and to implement the orders of Governor Jay Inslee.

On Monday, April 6 we will provide an overview of the response to date, including:

- a summary of support measures for residents;
- actions taken to support local small businesses;
- availability of city services during the Governor's "Stay Home, Stay Healthy" order; and
- resources available for those that need assistance.
