ORDINANCE NO. 6515

AN ORDINANCE 1) authorizing execution of a grant agreement (and supplements if necessary) with the Transportation Improvement Board (TIB) to accept up to \$5,000,000 in state funding to support construction of roadway improvements on 124th Avenue NE/NE 12th Street to NE Spring Boulevard project; and 2) amending the 2019-2025 General Capital Investment Program (CIP) Plan to increase the project budget for the 124th Avenue NE/NE 12th Street to NE Spring Boulevard Project (CIP Plan No. PW-R-169) by \$5,000,000.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON, DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The City Manager or his designee is authorized to execute a grant agreement (and supplements if necessary) with the Transportation Improvement Board (TIB) to accept up to \$5,000,000 in state funding to support construction of roadway improvements on 124th Avenue NE/NE 12th Street to NE Spring Boulevard project, a copy of which grant agreement shall be substantially in the form given Clerk's Receiving No. _____.

Section 2. The appropriate administrative officials of the City are hereby authorized to receive monies and to expend the same as authorized in said grant agreement.

Section 3. The City Manager or his designee shall have responsibility for the administration of said funds and expenditure of said funds received pursuant to said grant agreement and shall have all authority necessary to enter into agreements regarding the use thereof.

Section 4. The City's 2019-2025 General Capital Investment Program (CIP) Plan, adopted by Ordinance No. 6493 on December 2, 2019, as previously amended, is hereby further amended to increase the project budget for the 124th Avenue NE/NE 12th Street to NE Spring Boulevard Project (CIP Plan No. PW-R-169) by \$5,000,000.

Section 5. If the actual revenue received from TIB shall be more or less than the anticipated amount set forth herein, the appropriations to the CIP Fund and Plan shall be adjusted to be equal to the amount actually received.

Section 6. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force five (5) days after its passage and legal publication.
