SUBJECT: Crime Trend Update – COVID-19 influence

The Chief of Police will provide an overview of current crime trends in the City of Bellevue, focusing specifically on data from the last few months under the Stay Home, Stay Healthy order. We will include a brief discussion of actions taken to address increases in certain types of crime.

Over the last several weeks, the region has witnessed an increase in property crimes and incidents of domestic violence, among other crimes. The Bellevue Police Department (BPD) has been actively using its resources to prevent criminal activity in Bellevue and to identify and arrest suspects when crimes are committed. During this presentation Council will be provided the most updated crime data and efforts BPD employees are taking to address crime in Bellevue.
