ORDINANCE NO. 6517

AN ORDINANCE 1) authorizing execution of an Interagency Agreement with King County Wastewater Treatment Division for acceptance of \$150,000 for design and construction of a Trail Detour Project in Coal Creek Natural Area Park; 2) amending the 2019-2020 Operating Grants, Donations and Special Reserves Fund to increase the appropriation by \$150,000 in the King County Well-KEPT Project; and, 3) authorizing expenditures of said funds.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON, DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The City Manager or his designee is authorized to execute an
Interagency Agreement with King County Wastewater Treatment Division for
acceptance of \$150,000 for design and construction of a Trail Detour Project in Coal
Creek Natural Area Park, a copy of which interagency agreement shall be
substantially in the form given Clerk's Receiving No.

Section 2. The City Manager or his designee is hereby further authorized to execute all documents necessary to fulfill the terms of the agreement authorized in Section 1.

Section 3. The appropriate administrative officials of the City are hereby authorized to receive monies and to expend the same as authorized in said grant agreements.

Section 4. The City's 2019-2020 Operating Grants, Donations and Special Reserves Fund appropriation adopted by Ordinance No. 6493 on December 2, 2019, as previously amended, is hereby further amended to increase the appropriation to said Fund by \$150,000.

Section 5. If the actual revenue received from the anticipated sources specified in said grant agreements shall be more or less than the anticipated amount set forth herein, the appropriations shall be adjusted to equal the amount actually received.

Section 6. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force five (5) days after its passage and legal publication.
