
Proposed Amendments

Amendment Focus

- ➤ Improve Impact Fee Processes
 - Apply Refund & Reimbursement Cap
 Implication for development: This is rarely used and would impact very few projects.
 - Change Fee Collection Timing for Tenant Improvement
 & Affordable Housing Developments

Implication for development: This would end the practice of requiring upfront payments (for these permits/uses only).

Amendment Focus

- Provide Clarification & Consistency for Code Implementation
 - Clarify Fee Calculation & Existing Use Credit

 Implication for development: This would clarify existing practice. It may result in less credit for some projects.
 - Clarify Definitions / Relationship of Impact Fee Program to other Plans & Programs
 - Add Exemption for City Facilities (i.e. New Fire Station)
 Implication for development: None expected.
