Description and Scope

This project is a partnership with the Washington State Department of Transportation (WSDOT) to develop, evaluate and identify preferred alternative location(s) and configuration(s), as well as, preliminary design and cost estimation for South Downtown access to/from I-405 in support of implementation of the I-405 Master Plan.

Rationale

The I-405 Master Plan approved in 2002 includes a half-diamond interchange in Bellevue to improve access to/from south of the NE 6th Street interchange. Recent proposed development activities in Downtown and Wilburton areas have created a pressing need to identify and implement the project to improve connectivity and mobility in the south Downtown area to support economic development. Developing reliable cost estimation is necessary to inform state legislative consideration for funding. The Transportation Department is conducting a study to develop, evaluate and identify a preferred alternative location(s) and configuration(s) for consideration by WSDOT in conjunction with completion of the Master Plan.


Environmental Impacts
