## ORDINANCE NO. 6518

AN ORDINANCE amending the 2019-2025 General Capital Investment Program (CIP) Plan to create a new project entitled, South Downtown I-405 Access (CIP Plan No. PW-R-203) with a total project budget of \$300,000, with funding provided via a transfer of budget from the NE 4th Street Extension Project (CIP Plan No. PW-R-160).

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON, DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The City's 2019-2025 General Capital Investment Program (CIP) Plan, adopted by Ordinance No. 6493 on December 2, 2019 as previously amended, is hereby further amended to create a new project entitled, South Downtown I-405 Access (CIP Plan No. PW-R-203), a copy of which CIP Project Description (PW-R-203) is attached hereto as Attachment A.

Section 2. The City's 2019-2025 General CIP Plan, adopted by Ordinance No. 6493 on December 2, 2019 as previously amended, is hereby further amended to transfer \$300,000 from the NE 4th Street Extension Project (CIP Plan No. PW-R-160) to the South Downtown I-405 Access project (CIP Plan No. PW-R-203).

#### Description and Scope

This project is a partnership with the Washington State Department of Transportation (WSDOT) to develop, evaluate and identify preferred alternative location(s) and configuration(s), as well as, preliminary design and cost estimation for South Downtown access to/from I-405 in support of implementation of the I-405 Master Plan.

#### Rationale


The I-405 Master Plan approved in 2002 includes a half-diamond interchange in Bellevue to improve access to/from south of the NE 6th Street interchange. Recent proposed development activities in Downtown and Wilburton areas have created a pressing need to identify and implement the project to improve connectivity and mobility in the south Downtown area to support economic development. Developing reliable cost estimation is necessary to inform state legislative consideration for funding. The Transportation Department is conducting a study to develop, evaluate and identify a preferred alternative location(s) and configuration(s) for consideration by WSDOT in conjunction with completion of the Master Plan.

#### Environmental Impacts

Programmatic environmental review will be completed in conjunction with this project.

Operating Budget Impacts

Operating costs for this project will be determined during the project's design phase.
