Subject: Vacant EBCC Position

At the June 30 meeting, Position No. 4 was declared vacant and direction was given to recruit for the vacancy. The vacant position was advertised for three weeks, with 16 residents submitting applications.

At the August 4 meeting, the Community Council chose five applicants to be interviewed at tonight's meeting. Each candidate will be allowed to speak for 15 minutes, with three minutes for an opening statement and 12 minutes to reply to questions previously provided to them.

A discussion of EBCC candidate qualifications is included on tonight's agenda as an executive session item. As a reminder, final action appointing a candidate to elective office shall be in a meeting open to the public. Vacancies shall be filled by appointment for the remainder of an unexpired term by a majority vote of the remaining EBCC members. Tentatively, final action to appoint a candidate to elective office will occur at the October 6 meeting.
